Suggested Duties of Student Interns

- 1. Listening and aiding students with reading.
- 2. Reading and telling stories to students.
- 3. Helping students use tools and equipment.
- 4. Providing leadership in introducing or discussing a video.
- 5. Administering a make-up test.
- 6. Tutoring a small group or one-on-one.
- 7. Developing games that teach students selected skills.
- 8. Helping students in the library.
- 9. Supervising indoor/outdoor games.
- 10. Creating and carrying out lesson plans.
- 11. Gathering materials for projects or experiments.
- 12. Helping students who are slower learners.
- 13. Assist teacher in playground and field trip supervision.
- 14. Helping students with make-up work.
- 15. Leading classroom discussions.
- 16. Drilling students on vocabulary words, ABC's, sentence structure, and numbers. 17.

Operating projectors, overheads, and other instructional equipment.

- 18. Preparing audio-visual materials.
- 19. Duplicating materials.
- 20. Creating and carrying out lessons.
- 21. Assisting in fire drills.
- 22. Laminating materials.
- 23. Checking papers and filing occasionally.
- 24. Displaying student work.
- 25. Creating bulletin boards or classroom displays.
